Pre-Gulf War 1991

- Shipment of Clean Rooms Project to Al Fao Est., Baghdad
- Multiple container movements, including out-of-gauge and overland trucks
- On-site packing and loading

Pre-Iraq War 2003

- The **Oil-for-Food Programme**, established by the United Nations in 1995 and terminated in late 2003, was established with the stated intent to allow Iraq to sell oil on the world market in exchange for food, medicine, and other humanitarian needs for ordinary Iraqi citizens without allowing Iraq to boost its military capabilities.
- Redcliffe were actively involved in co-ordination of regular UN-approved shipments ex all EU origins, by FCL, LCL, breakbulk, and airfreight for the Ministry of Municipalities which incorporated agency representation at origin and final destination, assistance with application for Export Licences "in-country", on-carriages over the Iraqi borders via Aqaba, Amman and Lebanon with delivery orders and CMR notes signed by the UN officers. Tracking of all shipments. Maintaining our Redcliffe Baghdad office.
- Experience with working with UNICEF with frustrated shipments made during the Iraqi War, meeting with UNICEF and negotiating taking charge of such cargo, re-writing of contracts to satisfy the requirements of UNICEF and the supplier, and arranging the onward movement into Iraq under their care.

Post War to Present

We have been arranging on-going sea, land and air shipments for Water Treatment Infrastructure and Oil and Gas projects in the following Iraqi regions; Sulaimaniyah (North Iraq), Falloujah (West Iraq), Refai (South Iraq), Al Mowafaqia (between El Kut and Nassiriyah), Baghdad, Bazian (North Iraq), Al Majer (Nr Basrah), and Basrah.

These have been door to door shipments from suppliers in Europe, USA, Africa, and the Far East, utilising the transit countries of Turkey, Jordan, Kuwait and the UAE. We are also utilising the port of Umm Qasr, Iraq and have excellent representation there to support customs clearance and onward deliveries to inland project sites of Iraq.
